Other news:

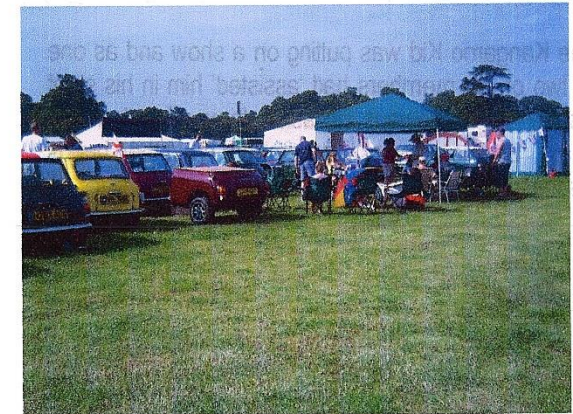

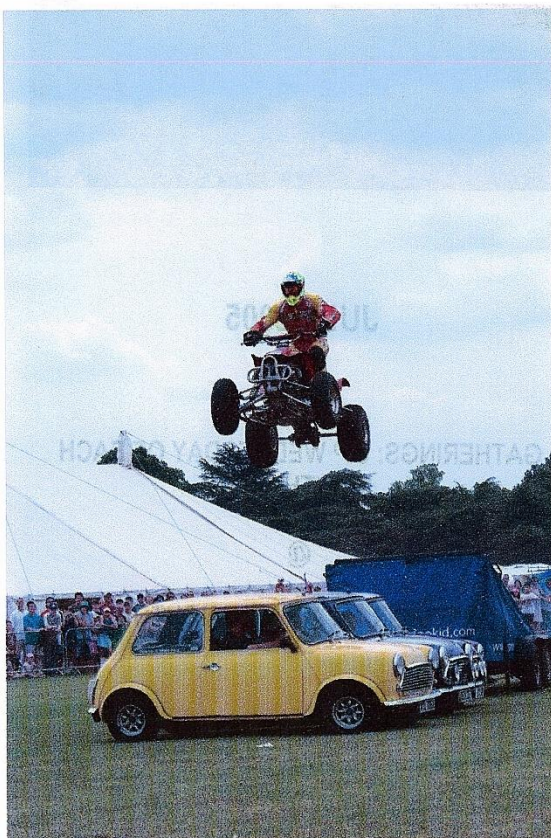
