Saturday 24th September 2005: Mike has thrown open his abode for us all to descend upon him and his family for a BBQ. No quad-biking on the lawn please...

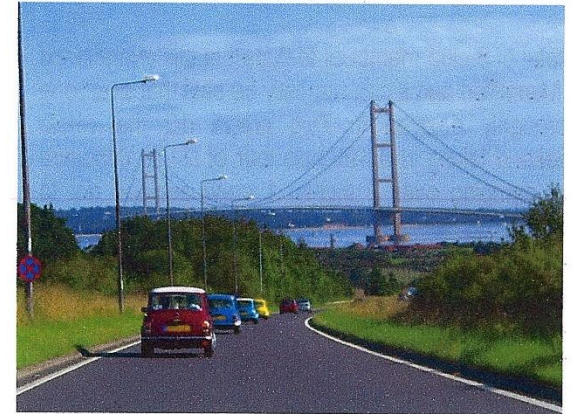
