SATURDAY 24TH SEPTEMBER 2005

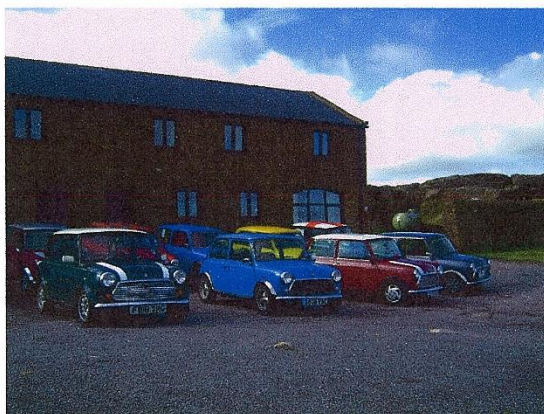
