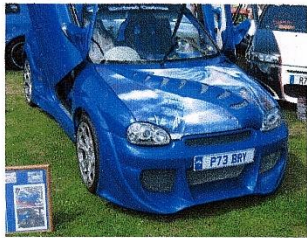


The best club stand was won by 'Mini Diddlers' from Retford, with Jeannie and Chris seen here accepting their trophy from Mike.

MINI DAY

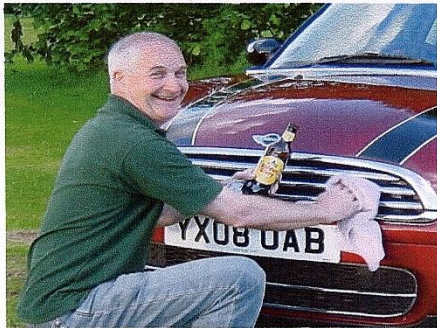
