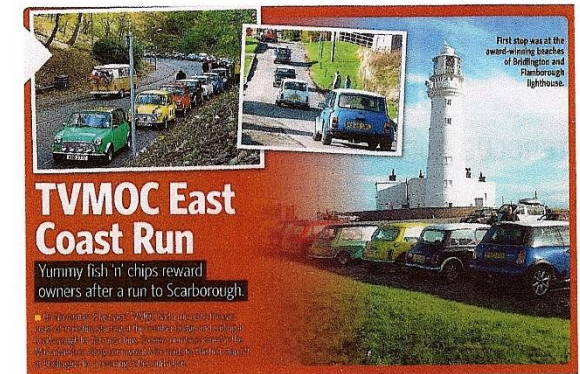


It was a great first run of the season and the weather gods were kind to us, as no-one likes cooking outside in the snow – though it wouldn't be the first time.
